

# THE LAW OF GOD

## OLD TESTAMENT

I

Thou shalt have no other gods before Me.

II

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the Lord thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me; and showing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep my commandments.

III

Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain; for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh His name in vain.

IV

Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days shalt thou labor, and do all thy work: but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the Lord thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day, and hallowed it.

V

Honor thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.

VI

Thou shalt not kill.

VII

Thou shalt not commit adultery

VIII

Thou shalt not steal.

IX

Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

X

Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor anything that is thy neighbor's.,

# THE LAW OF GOD

## AS CHANGED BY THE PAPACY

I

I am the Lord thy God. Thou shalt not have strange gods before Me.

(It will be observed that the second commandment as found in the Bible is left out).

II

Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain.

III

Remember that thou keep holy the Sabbath day. The "Doctrinal Catholic Catechism," page 174, has the following question and answer:

"Q.—Have you any other way of proving that the Church has power to institute festivals of precept?

"A.—Had she not such power ... she could not have substituted the observance of Sunday, the first day of the week, for Saturday, the seventh day, a change for which there is no Scriptural authority."

IV

Honor thy father and thy mother.

V

Thou shalt not kill.

VI

Thou shalt not commit adultery.

VII

Thou shalt not steal.

VIII

Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.

IX

Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's wife.

X

Thou shalt not covet thy neighbor's goods.

"What are the letters supposed to be in the Pope's crown, and what do they signify, if anything?"

"The letters inscribed in the Pope's miter are these: VICARIUS FILII DEI which is the Latin for: VICAR OF THE SON OF GOD.' Catholics hold that the church, which is a visible society, must have a visible head. Christ, before His ascension into heaven, appointed St. Peter to act as His representative.... Hence to the Bishop of Rome, as head of the church, was given the title, 'VICAR OF CHRIST.'"

## "HIS LOCATION"

"And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads..." Revelation 13:1

The word Mountains was translated from the Greek word Oros.

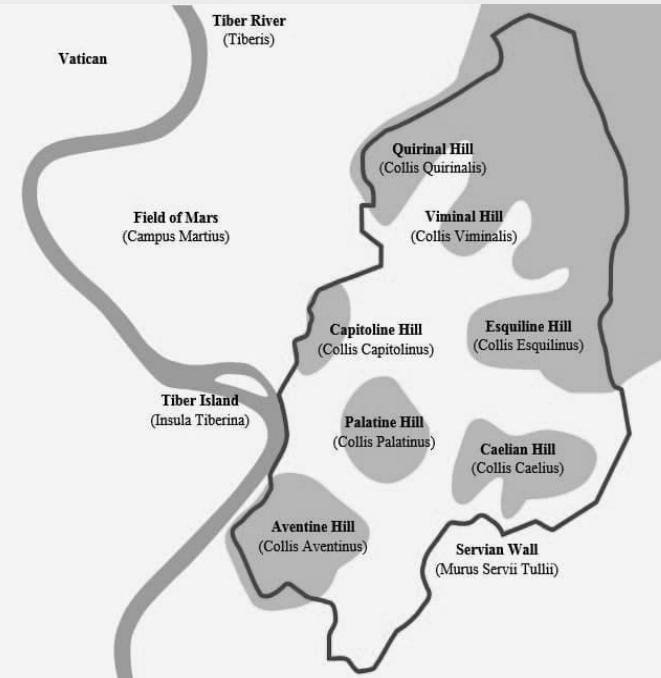
Strong's Concordance G3735 ὄρος oros or'-os  
Probably a from an obsolete word ὄρω orō (to rise or rear; perhaps akin to G142; compare G3733); a mountain (as lifting itself above the plain): -hill, mount (-ain).

"It is within the city of Rome, called The City on Seven Hills, that the entire area of Vatican State Proper is now confined" The Catholic Encyclopedia, p. 529.

Rome is known to be built upon seven hills. Rome was said to have been founded when Romulus and Remus, twin sons of Mars, ended up at the foot of the hill Palatine and founded the city. The other six hills are Capitoline (the seat of government), Quirinal, Viminal, Esquiline, Caelian, and Aventine.

## "HIS MARK"

"If any MAN WORSHIP the BEAST and HIS IMAGE, and receive HIS MARK in his forehead (decision), or in his hand." Revelation 14:9
